ELEMENTS OF THE SERVICE:

How do you want this service to feel? (eg. solemn, joyful)
What suggestions do you have about the order of the service?
PERSONAL INFORMATION:
Tell us a little about the jobs and career of the deceased.
(If married) How did the deceased meet his/her spouse?
What are some stories you recall about their years growing up?
What were some of his/her notable accomplishments?
What are some funny stories you remember?
What are some of your fondest memories?

What made this person special/unique? What are some examples to illustrate this?
What did you learn from the person's life? How did he/she make you a better person?
Did he/she have any favourite quotes/sayings?
What challenges did the deceased face, and how did he or she choose to address them?
ls there anything else that needs to be said to make the service complete?
SPIRITUAL LIFE:
What was his/her spiritual heritage – spiritual roots?
Do you know of any Bible verses or inspirational materials they had marked, highlighted, written down, memorized, or quoted frequently?
