Empowered Tongues, Interpretation of Tongues & Intercession

Scripture: 1 Cor 14:12-28, Acts 2, Romans 8:26-27, Luke 2:37

Big Idea: The gift of tongues and interpretation serve to edify His body and our soul, but only as an outpouring of a life filled with, empowered by the power of the Holy Spirit.

The Challenge: Often these gifts are seen as an end goal. Rather, they, like any of the other gifts, exist as an outpouring of life lived in the spirit.
